1. A poster session on Friday evening where scientists and clinicians present emerging research in Glycobiology and CDG.
2. SBP's innovative doctor-is-In session, where physicians and scientists meet with small groups of like-minded family members in a round-robin format, on Saturday afternoon.
3. Family/Scientist Networking time on Saturday evening.
