Scientific and family meetings will be bridged by three interactive events:

1. A poster session on Friday evening where scientists and clinicians present emerging research in Glycobiology and CDG.
2. Our biennial innovative doctor-is-in session, where physicians and scientists meet with small groups of family members in a round-robin format, on Saturday afternoon.
3. Family/Scientist Networking time on Saturday evening – a celebration.
